3	Large brown paper bag, brown, blue and green watercolor, black marker	21	White paper, white crayon, red & blue water color paint, ruler, masking tape
4	Black paper, white crayon, toothpick, flashlight	22	2 empty toilet paper rolls, construction paper, yarn or ribbon
5	Cardstock, construction paper, craft feathers	23	Brown paper grocery bag, 1 or 2 dark color markers
6	Empty egg carton, 2 toothpicks, white paper, either clay, play doughh or styrofoam	24	Empty pint size milk carton, white and brown construction paper, black cardstock
7	Yellow and green construction paper, popcorn	25	Sheet of white paper, vegetable oil, cotton ball
8	Vinegar, salt, sugar, cucumbers, onion	26	White, brown or black construction paper, googly eyes, yarn
9	Dried beans, small stones, bits of torn tissue, toy animals	27	2 handfuls stones and rocks, metallic gold paint, shallow pan, tub or sink
10	Paper	28	Cornmeal, salt, butter, whole milk, boiling water
11	Heavy whipping cream, clean jar, salt, optional: marble	29	Several colors of construction paper
12	Light blue construction paper, red, brown and green paint	30	Paper plate, 2 sheets black construction paper, 1 sheet black felt, black paint
13	Tin foil pie plate, thumbtack, old towel	31	3 c. soap flakes (Ivory Snow detergent or grate your own), vegetable oil, food coloring, bowl, water, 12 in. string
14	Flashlight	32	Stiff cardboard, metallic gold paint, nail or toothpick
15	Paper, marker, ribbon	33	Small lightweight hammer with wooden handle, acrylic paints
16	Red, white and blue paper	34	Large brown paper bag, hole punch, yarn or leather string
17	Salt, water, 3 c. any kind of berry, 100 % cotton white tee shirt	35	Apple, red tempura paint, white paper
